Subject: Study 52.60 - Sovereign Immunity (Dangerous Agricultural Chemicals)

You have previously received the consolidated recommendation relating to sovereign immunity. Contained in that recommendation at pages 37-43 and 75-77 are the Commission's recommendations relating to liability for the use of pesticides. The latter have been distributed for comment and attached to this memorandum are the letters received (Exhibits I-III) in response to this distribution. The comments received each reflect the sentiments of the Director of the California Department of Agriculture who stated:


