Subject: 1983 Legislative Program

Attached is a report on the 1983 Legislative Program.

You will note that we were unable to find an author to introduce the dismissal of civil actions for lack of prosecution recommendation. We plan to put this item on the agenda for our June 1983 meeting so the Commission can give further consideration to the recommendation.

We plan to amend Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 2 to authorize the Commission to study the topics of family law (expanding the previously authorized study of community property) and real and personal property law (which will include a number of previously authorized topics that fall under this general topic).

We have listed on the attached report the agenda meeting materials that relate to the various bills listed in the 1983 Legislative Program. We will discuss each of the bills in more detail in connection with the meeting materials that relate to that bill.
