Subject: Study #38 - Inter Vivos Rights of Spouse in Probate Code Section 201.5 Property

The 1957 session of the Legislature authorized the Commission to make a study to determine what the inter vivos rights of one spouse should be in property acquired by the other spouse during marriage while domiciled outside California. This is a follow-up to our study dealing with the disposition of such property upon the death of the acquiring spouse.

We retained Professor Harold Marsh of the School of Law at UCLA to do this study for us. His study has been completed and is attached hereto. I suggest that we take it up at the May, 1958 meeting of the Commission.
