Memorandum No. 3

Subject: 1959 Legislative Program.

As of this date it seems to me that the following are the practical possibilities with respect to the Commission's 1959 legislative program:

1. Reasonably certain to be included:

1. Suspension Absolute Power Alienation
11. Corp. Code §§ 2201, 3901 (Sale of Assets).
16. Planning Procedure where no planning commission.
19. Penal and Vehicle Code Overlap.
20. Guardians for Nonresidents.
21. Confirmation Partition Sales.
22. Cut-off Date, Motion New Trial.
24. Mortgages Future Advances.
25. Probate Code § 259 (Right Nonresident Aliens to Inherit).
31. Doctrine Worthier Title.
44. Suit Common Name.
56. Narcotics Code.
58. Codification of Grand Jury Law

2. Fairly likely to be included:

- 23. Rescission Contracts.
- 32. Arbitration.
- 37. Claims Statute.
- 38. Inter vivos rights, Probate Code § 201.5 property.
- 45. Rights Unlicensed Contractor.

3. Some chance of being included:

- 26. Law Governing Escheat.
- 33. Survival of Tort Actions.
- 34. Uniform Rules Evidence.
- 40. Notice of Alibi.
- 41. Small Claims Court Law.
- 42. Rights Good Faith Improver Property.
- 46. Arson.
- 48. Juvenile's Right to Counsel.
- 54. Use Term "Ward Juvenile Court."

At the September meeting it might be advisable to select from categories (1) and (2) above what will be the 1959 program with the thought that these should be given, if not the exclusive attention of the Commission for the next few months, at least priority. For example, if it were decided not to present any part of the Uniform Rules of Evidence in 1959, we should perhaps put this study aside insofar as the agenda of ~~Commission meetings~~ are concerned until we have completed our work on the 1959 legislative program.
