1957 Session

Senate Bill No. 33 -- Taking Instructions to Jury Room.

Assembly Bill No. 246 -- Retention of Venue for Convenience of Witnesses.

Assembly Bill No. 247 -- Dead Man Statute.

Assembly Bill No. 248 -- Marital "for and against" Testimonial Privilege.

1959 Session

Senate Bill No. 160 -- Right of Nonresident Aliens To Inherit.

Assembly Bill No. 400 -- Overlapping Penal and Vehicle Code Sections re Taking of Vehicles.

Assembly Bill No. 402 -- Overlapping Penal and Vehicle Code Sections re Drunk Driving.

Assembly Bill No. 403 -- Notice of Sale of All Or Substantially All of Corporate Assets by Corporation Formed To Make Such Sale.
