Subject: Election of officers of Law Revision Commission

The Commission should elect a Chairman and a Vice Chairman at its November meeting. This will permit us to report the new officers in our 1966 Annual Report and to obtain new letterheads before the new officers take office. The term of the new officers will commence on January 1, 1966.

The following is an extract from the Handbook of Practices and Procedures of the Law Revision Commission:

The officers of the Commission are the Chairman and the Vice Chairman. The term of office of the Chairman and Vice Chairman is two years, commencing in January of each evennumbered year. No officer is eligible to succeed himself in the same office in which he has served a full term. However, an officer who has served for less than a full term may succeed himself in the same office for a full term; and, where the Chairman is reelected to the office, the incumbent Vice Chairman is eligible for reelection even though his reelection may result in his succeeding himself for another full term.

The Chairman and Vice Chairman each have served a full two-year term.
