Subject: Publication of Commission's Tentative Recommendations

We have made arrangements with the California Law Review to publish the research study on Leases. The California Law Review wants to publish the research study and the tentative recommendation as a package. We have already distributed this tentative recommendation for comments and will approve a revised tentative recommendation for distribution for comments at the June maeting. We would like authority to permit the California Law Review to publish the revised tentative recommendation in their August issue.

We have made arrangements for the publication in the Stanford Law
Review of the research study on Right to Possession Prior to Final Judgment.
We will approve the tentative recommendation on this subject at the June
meeting and we would like authority to have the tentative recommendation
published with the research study if the review is willing to publish it.
The review will be published in August.

We are hopeful that we will have a staff study on Additur ready for publication in a law review early in July. If so, we would like to have authority to publish the tentative recommendation on this subject in a law review if the review is willing to publish it. If we receive any significant comments on the tentative recommendation—comments are due July l—we would wait until after the July meeting to authorize publication.

It is possible that we may have the Fictitious Name Statute research study ready for publication in time to publish it in a law review. If so, we would like to also publish the tentative recommendation and request authority to do so.
