Memorandum 69-85

Subject: Annual Report for 1969 Year

Attached is a draft of the Annual Report for 1969. We have sent this to the printer, but a substantial number of revisions will be needed. (We are holding the type from the last Annual Report and will be making changes in that type when we prepare the type for the 1969 Annual Report.) We made some editorial changes in this material before we sent it to the printer. If we receive copy back from the printer before the meeting, we will provide you with a copy of the report in "clean" form.

Pages 2-4

These pages will be revised later to reflect the content of the Report when finally ready to print.

Pages 5-7

These pages have been revised on the assumption that the claims statute bill will pass and that the lease bill will not pass.

Pages 8-9

These pages will be revised later to reflect the facts that occur prior to the final printing of the report (approximately December 1, 1969--see letter of transmittal on page 2).

Page 10

This page will, of course, need to be revised to reflect the actual Recommendations that will be submitted to the 1970 Legislature.

Pages 11-16

This is an expansion of the similar discussion that the Commission determined should be included in the last Annual Report. We believe that there is considerable value in the expanded discussion in view of the concern of some members of the Legislature as to what the Commission is accomplishing.

Pages 17-22

This portion assumes that the lease bill will not be enacted and that the claims statute bill will be enacted. Any necessary revisions will be made before the report is finally printed.

Pages 23-29

Any revisions necessary to reflect the actual Recommendations to the 1970 Legislature will be made before the report is printed.

Pages 30-33

The Commission has previously determined that these topics should be dropped from the agenda. The discussion of the first two topics has been previously approved. The discussion of the jury instruction topic is in accord with the Commission's direction as to the content of this discussion but has not previously been approved.

Page 34

The Report on Statutes Repealed By Implication or Held Unconstitutional will be considered in a separate Memorandum.

We hope to have the Annual Report substantially set in type for the October meeting so that it can be approved for printing at that meeting and can be printed early in December. We hope at the September meeting to approve the major portions of the report that present policy questions. The remainder of the report is routine.
