First Supplement to Memorandum 72-53

Subject: Proposed Budget for 1973-74 Fiscal Year

We have received additional instructions on the computation of the amount to be included in the budget for personsl services. The result is that the amounts for 2972-73 and 1973-74 for personal services are reduced. The reduction is based on the assumption that the President's Pay Board will stand by ita decision to reduce the salary increase provided by the 1972 Legislature by one percent in some categories. (The pay increase being between 5 and 8 percent and being the first increase in two years, we had prepared the budget attached to Memorandum 72-53 on the assumption that the entire increase would be approved.)

We have allocated the funds made available by the salary reduction to various items of operating expenses which were budgeted at unrealiatically low levels in the proposed budget attached to Memorandum 72-53. The revised budget is attached. The staff recommends that it be approved subject to any revisions required if additional instructions are received from the Department of Finance. The proposed budget is within the amount tentatively allocated to the Commiasion by the administration.
