Subject: Probate Code Study Schedule

At the January meeting, the Commission considered but deferred any action concerning the Probate Code study schedule.

Attached as Exhibit 1 is a tentative schedule for preparation of a new Probate Code. The staff will follow this schedule, as revised by the Commission, in planning and scheduling material for consideration by the Commission. The schedule also is useful because it indicates to interested persons the meeting at which particular matters are likely to be first considered.

Exhibit 2 indicates the State Bar consultants who are primarily responsible for review of particular matters.

The tentative schedule contemplates that a complete draft of Division 7 (administration) and some other portions of the new Code will be available after the September meeting. When this draft is available the entire staff plans to review the draft with care, and we are hopeful that the State Bar consultants will sit with us when we review the portions for which they are primarily responsible. We expect that this review will take at least two weeks of full time work.

Attached as Exhibit 3 is a tentative outline of Division 7 (administration of decedent's estates) of the new Probate Code.
