Subject: Election of Officers

On June 30, 1986, the terms of office of the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson will expire. New officers should be elected at the June meeting.

The Commission has adopted the policy that no officer is eligible to succeed himself or herself in the same office in which the officer has served a full term. The Manual contains the following statement concerning this matter (with a staff revision to reflect the most recent election of officers for a term commencing on July 1):

The officers of the Commission are the Chairperson and the Vice Chairperson. The term of office of the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson is one year, commencing on December-31 July 1 of each year. No officer is eligible to succeed himself or herself in the same office in which the officer has served a full term. However, an officer who has served for less than a full term may succeed himself or herself in the same office for a full term; and, where the Chairperson is reelected to office, the incumbent Vice Chairperson is eligible for reelection even though reelection may result in the Vice Chairpersons succeeding himself or herself for another full term.

If the Commission approves the revision indicated above, the officers elected at the June 1986 meeting will take office on July 1, 1986, and the one-year term would end on June 30, 1987.
