

Memorandum 95-40

Schedule of Future Meetings

At the July 1995 meeting the Commission decided to try a system of more frequent but shorter meetings. This would enable consistent progress on Commission projects, keep Commissioners fresh on Commission projects, allow the staff to schedule its work more efficiently, enable greater flexibility in scheduling to achieve maximum Commissioner attendance, and encourage Commissioner attendance during the full period of the scheduled meeting. The increased cost to the Commission for transportation to more frequent meetings would be offset by reduced cost for accommodations and meals at each meeting.

The staff has reviewed the calendar for the next year and suggests the following tentative schedule of future meetings, taking into account holidays, vacations, etc. If Commissioners will review their schedules, we can change or finalize some of these dates at the August meeting. We do not propose to alter the scheduled September 1995 two-day meeting, since that is being held in conjunction with the State Bar's annual meeting. We would not schedule beyond July 1996 until we have had a chance to evaluate our experience at the 1995 State Bar meeting and decide whether to do a repeat in 1996.
