First Supplement to Memorandum 95-75**Homestead Exemption: Proceeds Exemption (Letter from CLTA)**

Attached to this supplement is a letter from Sandra L. Fuhrman on behalf of the California Land Title Association. Ms. Fuhrman states that CLTA will not be able to comment on the current proposals or to amplify on their earlier letter until after the Commission's December meeting. She does, however, speculate that CLTA would probably be opposed to any procedure calling for homestead exemption proceeds to be held by title companies or in escrow. She also believes that we will be able to deal with potential revisions or amendments as needed.

The staff suggests that the Commission proceed on the basis of the draft revisions set forth in Memorandum 95-75. If any issues are raised by CLTA or others, the Commission can address them at the January 19 meeting.
