## 1996 Legislative Program: Final Report

Attached to this memorandum is a chart showing final action on the Commission's 1996 legislative program.

The Commission should be aware of the following additional information.

## SB 1510 (Kopp) — Civil Procedure Omnibus Bill

This measure had contained, in addition to other unrelated civil procedure matters, the Commission's recommendation on tolling the statute of limitations while the defendant is out of state. We removed most of the tolling provisions from the bill during the legislative process because Consumer Attorneys' concern about them threatened to impede passage of the remainder of the bill. The Commission plans to reintroduce the tolling recommendation in a separate bill next session in the Assembly.

Removal of the tolling provisions from the bill was not complete — we kept a small related but noncontroversial segment dealing with trial court delay reduction. According to the Governor's veto message, his veto of SB 1510 was prompted by other provisions in the bill, not the trial court delay reduction segment. Consequently, when we reintroduce the tolling recommendation next session, we will include the trial court delay reduction segment with it.
