Suggested Revisions of Meeting Schedule

The staff has two suggested revisions of the Commission's meeting schedule.

December 1997

The Commission tentatively scheduled a two-day meeting for December 11-12 (Thu.–Fri.) in Sacramento, in contemplation of a possible Senate Judiciary Committee interim study session on SB 209 in conjunction with the Commission meeting.

It now appears that the interim study session will be held separately on December 3, so a two-day meeting is not required. The staff suggests a return to the originally-scheduled December 11 meeting date in Sacramento, unless it appears that a December 12 meeting instead would achieve better Commissioner attendance.

December 1998

The Commission's December 1998 meeting is currently scheduled for December 7 (Mon.) in Sacramento.

Commissioner Gregory has pointed out that this is the day the 1999 Legislature convenes, so this meeting date would preclude attendance by him and by the legislators on the Commission. The staff suggests this meeting date be moved to Friday, December 11, by which date the Legislature likely will have recessed. This shift would also give the Commission's staff a little extra time to prepare materials for the meeting, bearing in mind the intervening Thanksgiving holiday period.
