## Memorandum 2009-39

**2009 Legislative Program: Final Report**

---

The attached chart indicates the final status of the Commission's 2009 legislative program.

Note that SB 308 (Harman) was signed into law. That bill would implement the Commission's recommendation on *Revision of No Contest Clause Statute: Conforming Revisions*, 38 Cal. L. Revision Comm'n Reports 203 (2008), as well as one piece of the Commission's recommendation on *Donative Transfer Restrictions*, 38 Cal. L. Revision Comm'n Reports 107 (2008) (a proposed Probate Code section on calculating degrees of kinship or consanguinity).

Those provisions were also included in SB 105 (Harman), which was held over as a two-year bill in order to provide more time to identify and address concerns of the California Judges Association. When that bill continues to be considered in 2010, it will need to be amended to remove the provisions enacted by SB 308.

SB 189 (Lowenthal) was also held as a two-year bill. Issues relating to that bill are discussed separately, in Memorandum 2009-45.
