## First Supplement to Memorandum 2011-20

**2011 Legislative Program: AB 1402 (Committee on Public Safety)**

---

Assembly Bill 1402 (Committee on Public Safety) is a clean-up bill relating to last year's nonsubstantive reorganization of the deadly weapon statutes. The bill was recently amended to (1) coordinate it with other pending bills, and (2) insert a contingency clause, to ensure that the bill will only become operative if the nonsubstantive reorganization becomes operative. These are purely technical amendments that do not require Commission action.

AB 1402 was heard in the Senate Committee on Public Safety earlier this week. The bill passed out of the committee, and is now pending on the Senate floor.
