Meeting Schedule

At its April 2015 meeting, the Commission¹ discussed the possibility of meeting in the King Hall School of Law *twice* each year, rather than once as has been the recent practice. In that discussion, Commissioner Cowett suggested that the December 2015 meeting, currently scheduled to be held in San Diego, might be moved to King Hall.²

The staff suggested that the matter be revisited at the June 2015 meeting and the Commission concurred. This memorandum is intended as a vehicle for that discussion.

The staff would like to propose a possible modification to the ideas raised at the April meeting. If the purpose of meeting more frequently in King Hall is to provide a greater opportunity for King Hall students and faculty to attend, December might not be the best time to achieve that goal. The December meeting is scheduled for December 10, 2015, which is in the middle of final exams.

Another possibility would be to schedule one meeting in King Hall for each of the academic semesters (for example, in February and October). A meeting near the beginning of the Fall Semester could also capitalize on other outreach efforts that are contemplated for the beginning of the academic year (i.e., an annual reception for students interested in working with the Commission or the Legislature generally).
