

## Memorandum 2017-4

**Fish and Game Law: Tentative Recommendation**

---

The Commission<sup>1</sup> has been studying a proposed recodification of the existing Fish and Game Code. The staff is presently preparing a draft tentative recommendation for the Commission's approval that would propose revision and reorganization of approximately two-thirds of that code. Revision of the remaining provisions of the existing code will be presented in a future draft tentative recommendation.

The draft tentative recommendation presently being prepared, which will exceed 900 pages, is very nearly completed. However, the draft will likely not be ready for publication by the upcoming meeting, and certainly not sufficiently in advance of the meeting to allow for any meaningful review of the document.

The staff apologizes for any inconvenience, and fully expects to present the draft tentative recommendation at the Commission's April 2017 meeting.
