## Memorandum 2018-4

**2018 Legislative Program (Status Report)**

---

Legislation to implement three Commission recommendations<sup>1</sup> will be introduced in 2018:

- Assembly Member Chau has introduced Assembly Bill 1739 to implement the Commission's recommendation on *Revocable Transfer on Death Deed: Recordation* (April 2017). This bill has been introduced as an urgency measure.
- Assembly Member Jones-Sawyer will author a bill to implement the Commission's recommendation on *Deadly Weapons: Minor Clean-Up Issues (Part 2)* (December 2015).
- Senator Roth has introduced Senate Concurrent Resolution 91 to renew the Commission's existing study authority.

At this time, no legislator has expressed interest in introducing legislation to implement the Commission's recommendations on *Relationship Between Mediation Confidentiality and Attorney Malpractice and Other Misconduct* (December 2017) or *Homestead Exemption: Dwelling* (September 2017).

The staff will update this information orally at the February meeting.
