## **Meeting Schedule**

At the March 2022 meeting, the Commission cancelled its April meeting and decided that it would revisit its 2022 meeting schedule at the May meeting. Those decisions were based on a correct assumption that the Executive Order that enabled meetings to be entirely remote would expire at the end of March, without a replacement. As a result, the Commission would be returning to inperson meetings after March.

Because of the practical difficulties posed by meeting in person (including travel time and costs), there is a good argument for returning to the Commission's pre-COVID practice of meeting every other month.

That could be most easily achieved by cancelling the meetings struck out below:
