Meeting Schedule

At the March 2022 meeting, the Commission cancelled its April meeting and decided that it would revisit its 2022 meeting schedule at the May meeting. Those decisions were based on a correct assumption that the Executive Order that enabled meetings to be entirely remote would expire at the end of March, without a replacement. As a result, the Commission would be returning to in-person meetings after March.

Because of the practical difficulties posed by meeting in person (including travel time and costs), there is a good argument for returning to the Commission's pre-COVID practice of meeting every other month.

That could be most easily achieved by cancelling the meetings struck out below:
