Meeting Schedule

This memorandum provides an update on the Commission's meeting schedule for 2024. The schedule was approved by the Commission at its December 21, 2023, meeting. At that meeting the staff informed the Commission that we would propose, at the Commission's February 15, 2024, meeting, which of those meetings the staff recommends for in-person meetings, with all Commissioners present at one location, and which of those meetings that staff recommend hybrid meetings, with Commissioners participating from various locations. Both In-person and Hybrid meetings will be open to the public.

- June 20, 2024, 9:30 a.m. 1:30 p.m.: In-person meeting Silicon Valley.
- August 15, 2024, 9:30 a.m. 1:30 p.m.: In-person meeting Los Angeles.
- September 12, 2024, 9:30 a.m. 1:30 p.m.: Hybrid meeting.
- October 10, 2024, 9:30 a.m. 1:30 p.m.: Hybrid meeting.
- November 7, 2024, 9:30 a.m. 1:30 p.m.: Hybrid meeting.
- December 5, 2024, 9:30 a.m. 1:30 p.m.: Hybrid meeting.

This proposed schedule would allow Commissioners to plan attendance at both Inperson and Hybrid meetings, subject to possible future reduction or modification. The Commission should decide whether to adopt the proposed schedule of Hybrid and Inperson meetings, with or without changes.
