McAllister Elected Chair of Law Revision Commission

Jane McAllister, of Hilmar, has been elected Chairperson of the California Law Revision Commission and attorney Victor King, of Los Angeles, has been elected Vice-Chairperson. The term of office is one year, ending on August 31, 2019.

The Law Revision Commission is a state agency responsible for studying problem areas in California law and recommending reforms to the Governor and Legislature. The Commission's current workload includes studies of alternatives to probate, revision of statutes made obsolete by trial court restructuring, and the reorganization and clean up of the Fish and Game Code, California Public Records Act, and certain statutes regulating toxic substances.

Jane McAllister, the new Chairperson, was appointed to the Commission in 2015. She is a graduate of Stanford University, where she received a Bachelor of Arts degree, with honors. She received her Juris Doctorate degree from the Humphreys College School of Law. Ms. McAllister has been a partner at McAllister and McAllister Inc. since 1996. She was an associate at Damrell, Nelson, Schrimp, Pallios, Pacher and Silva from 1988 to 1996.

Vice-Chairperson Victor King was appointed to the Commission in 2011. He is a graduate of the University of Chicago, where he received Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts degrees. He received his Juris Doctorate degree from the University of Michigan Law School. Mr. King has been university legal counsel for California State University, Los Angeles since 2002. He was a partner at Lewis Brisbois Bisgaard and Smith LLP from 2001 to 2002 and an associate from 1999 to 2001. He was a trustee at the Glendale Community College District from 1997 to 2009.
