**Third Decennial Review of Exemptions from
Enforcement of Money Judgments**

Request for Public Comment

Code of Civil Procedure Section 703.120 requires the Law Revision Commission, every 10 years, to review the amounts that are exempt from the enforcement of money judgments.

This tentative recommendation presents the results of the Commission's third decennial review. In this review, the Commission found that the existing statutory mechanism for making automatic adjustments to the exemption amounts is functioning properly and appears to obviate the need for any further manual adjustments.

The Commission therefore tentatively recommends that Section 703.120 be amended to delete the decennial review requirement.
