## Mechanics Lien Law: Clean-Up Legislation

## **Request for Public Comment**

In 2010, the Legislature enacted Chapter 697 of the Statutes of 2010, which implemented a Commission recommendation to reorganize and recodify statutory mechanics lien law. The legislation will become operative on July 1, 2012.

The Commission now seeks input on a tentative recommendation that proposes certain statutory clean-up before the new statutory scheme becomes operative. In particular, the proposed legislation would accomplish the following:

- Implement conforming revisions that were chaptered out by other bills enacted in 2010.
  - Correct minor technical errors.
