## Trial Court Restructuring: Rights and Responsibilities of the County as Compared to the Superior Court (Part 1)

## **Request for Public Comment**

The Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on a tentative recommendation proposing revision of a number of statutes to reflect trial court restructuring. This tentative recommendation proposes revisions relating to the following topics:

- Funding of court operations.
- Management of courts and employment of court personnel.
- Accounting by the courts.
- References to a judicial district.
- Fines, forfeitures, and deposits relating to a violation of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act (Bus. & Prof. Code § 25762).
- Money collected relating to a failure to provide proof of responsibility for a vehicle (Penal Code § 1463.22).

The Commission is continuing its work on trial court restructuring and plans to address other subjects in future recommendations.
