Deadly Weapons: Minor Clean-Up Issues

Request for Public Comment

The California Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its proposal to address some minor clean-up issues relating to the statutes governing control of deadly weapons.

Specifically, the Commission's tentative recommendation would:

- (1) Expand the scope of certain definitions ("application to purchase," "firearm safety device," "locked container," "short-barreled rifle," and "short-barreled shotgun") to cover the entirety of Part 6 of the Penal Code.
- (2) Standardize references to the federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives.
- (3) Standardize references to the "facility's manager" for a gun show or event.

The Commission is continuing to study the minor clean-up issues identified in Appendix B of its report on *Nonsubstantive Reorganization of Deadly Weapon Statutes*, 38 Cal. L. Revision Comm'n Reports 217 (2009). The Commission welcomes comments relating to any of those issues.
