Ownership of Amounts Withdrawn from Joint Account

Request for Public Comment

The Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its tentative recommendation that the California Multiple-Party Accounts Law be revised to make clear that ownership of funds withdrawn from a joint account is based on the proportionate contributions of the parties to the account. This would reverse the rule of *Lee v. Yang*, 111 Cal. App. 4th 481, 3 Cal. Rptr. 3d 819 (2003), holding that a party who withdraws funds from a joint account owns the funds regardless of their source. The Commission also tentatively recommends clarification of the existing rule that withdrawal of sums on deposit in a joint account severs the right of survivorship in the amounts withdrawn to the extent of the ownership interest of the withdrawing party. The proposed revisions would not affect the law relating to spousal rights in a joint account, which are governed by a separate provision.
