**Brian Hebert Appointed Executive Secretary of
Law Revision Commission**

Brian Hebert has been appointed Executive Secretary of the California Law Revision Commission. He replaces Nathaniel Sterling, who has retired.

The Law Revision Commission is a state agency responsible for studying problem areas in California law and recommending needed reforms to the Governor and Legislature. Projects currently underway include clarification of common interest development law, overhaul of mechanics lien law, development of a revocable transfer on death deed, improvement of the rules of civil discovery, and other matters.

Brian Hebert joined the Commission's legal staff in 1996, and was promoted to the position of Assistant Executive Secretary in 2002. Mr. Hebert received both his law degree and undergraduate degree from the University of California at Berkeley. He is a member of the Order of the Coif.

Nathaniel Sterling joined the Commission's legal staff in 1970 and has served as its Executive Secretary for the past 15 years. During Mr. Sterling's service, the Commission submitted nearly 300 recommendations to the California Legislature; nearly 18,000 statute sections were added, amended, or repealed on recommendation of the Commission.
