**Fish and Wildlife Code Part 1
(Divisions 1-4)**

Request for Public Comment

The California Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its tentative recommendation proposing a recodification of the existing Fish and Game Code, to be enacted as a new Fish and Wildlife Code. The new code would continue the substance of the former code in a more user-friendly form, without making any significant substantive change to the effect of existing law.

The tentative recommendation is proposed in response to a request from the Legislature that the Commission conduct a comprehensive review and clean-up of the Fish and Game Code, noting "the need for a comprehensive, thorough review and updating of the Fish and Game Code, to identify obsolete, inconsistent or duplicative sections, and to provide support for more readily understood and enforceable fish and wildlife regulations."

This tentative recommendation presents Divisions 1-4 of the proposed code. Future tentative recommendations will present the remainder of the proposed code.
