Fish and Game Law: Technical Revisions and Minor Substantive Improvements (Part 1)

Request for Public Comment


The California Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its proposal to make minor technical and substantive improvements to the Fish and Game Code. Specifically, the Commission's tentative recommendation would:

- Clarify the application of statutes to "parts" of regulated animals.
- Promote consistency in the application of statutes to amphibians and reptiles.
- Make clear that the law does not prohibit the Department of Fish and Wildlife from making unofficial translations of its statements and reports.
- Restate confusing language to make its meaning clearer, without affecting its substance.
- Make other minor stylistic and technical revisions.
