Technical and Minor Substantive Statutory Corrections

Request for Public Comment

The California Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its proposal to correct a number of technical and minor substantive defects in California statutes.

The tentative recommendation addresses the following matters:

- Consistency in treatment of privileged communications.
- Correction of gender-specific language.
- Correction of incorrect cross-references.
- Correction of obsolete cross-references.
- Consistency in treatment of spouses and domestic partners.
- Revision of numbering consistent with statutory conventions.
- Deletion of obsolete provisions.

The tentative recommendation is available from the California Law Revision Commission, 4000 Middlefield Road, Room D-2, Palo Alto, CA 94303-4739. The tentative recommendation is also available on the Commission's website (www.clrc.ca.gov) through the pull-down "Reports" menu.

The Commission often substantially revises its recommendations in response to public comment. To receive timely consideration, comments should be submitted to the Commission by **July 1, 2013**.

The Commission's study of technical and minor substantive statutory defects is ongoing. The Commission welcomes suggestions regarding other California statutes that appear in need of technical or minor substantive revision.
