Technical and Minor Substantive Statutory Corrections

Request for Public Comment

The California Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its proposal to correct a number of technical and minor substantive defects in California statutes.

Among the statutory revisions addressed by the tentative recommendation are:

- Incorrect cross-references.
- An obsolete reference to a "docket."
- Obsolete language authorizing a judge to substitute for a clerk.
- Provisions that are obsolete due to expiration of deadlines or similar events.

The tentative recommendation is available from the California Law Revision Commission, 4000 Middlefield Road, Room D-1, Palo Alto, CA 94303-4739. The tentative recommendation is also available on the Commission's website (www.clrc.ca.gov) through the pull-down "Reports" menu.

The Commission often substantially revises its recommendations in response to public comment. To receive timely consideration, comments should be submitted to the Commission by **July 31, 2006**.

The Commission's study of technical and minor substantive statutory defects is ongoing. The Commission welcomes suggestions regarding other California statutes that appear in need of technical or minor substantive revision.
