**Technical and Minor Substantive Statutory Corrections:
References to Recording Technology**

Request for Public Comment

The California Law Revision Commission seeks public comment on its proposal to revise various code sections in order to modernize provisions that relate to audio or video recording. Specifically, references to the use of a "tape," "cassette," "audiotape," or "videotape" would be replaced with general language that is not limited to a particular recording technology.

The tentative recommendation is available from the California Law Revision Commission, 4000 Middlefield Road, Room D-1, Palo Alto, CA 94303-4739. The tentative recommendation is also available on the Commission's website (www.clrc.ca.gov) through the pull-down "Reports" menu.

The Commission often substantially revises its recommendations in response to public comment. To receive timely consideration, comments on this recommendation should be submitted to the Commission by **June 30, 2007**.

The Commission's study of technical and minor substantive statutory revisions is ongoing. The Commission welcomes suggestions regarding other California statutes that appear in need of technical or minor substantive revision.
